The InternNE program connects college students and employers from across the state, providing a unique opportunity for them to co-invest in the future. Interns gain valuable business experience that will help them in future careers, while successful internships help businesses develop tomorrow's leaders.

The program provides a 40% match, up to \$3,500 per internship, for eligible businesses hiring eligible student interns (businesses in distressed areas may receive a 60% match up to \$5,000).

Eligible businesses are primarily in Manufacturing, Research & Development, Distribution, Transportation, Storage & Warehousing, Data Processing, Telecommunications, Insurance & Financial Services; businesses headquartered in Nebraska are also eligible.
